

New Educator Process

Thank you for your interest in becoming part of our education team! We are excited to help you along this journey, and look forward to the potential opportunity of working with you in the future.

As a regional educator, you will be working closely with a distributor in your area. If you haven't already, please identify who that distributor is. If you need assistance in this, you can find the information on our website www.babehairextensions.com The steps listed below are requirements that must be completed to join our education team, whether interested in educating for hair extensions or eyelash extensions.

Step #1: Getting to know your Distributor & Extension Experience

- Be a licensed cosmetologist in the state of your residence for hair extensions, or a licensed esthetician for eyelash extensions
- Trained at a Babe Hair or Eyelash Extension class or through the online education videos
- Be currently using Babe Hair or Eyelash Extensions for at least a year
- Have knowledge and application experience in all four methods of hair extensions: Tape In, Beaded, Fusion & Sew In Wefts. For eyelash extensions, have knowledge in Classic & Volume lash applications
- Submit a resume to Kari Fuller or your distributor
- Take part in an interview with the distributor to determine steps for success with them: such as pay, frequency of classes, tools supplied, etc.

Step #2: Education Training with Babe

- Submit 3 pictures of your extension work to Kari Fuller: these photos should show the before and after effects of the extensions for either hair or eyelashes.
- Watch the online education videos through the perspective of an educator. Access will be granted by Kari Fuller to these videos at no cost.
- Send in a 5 minute video of yourself teaching a section of a class. The materials and assignment will be given by Kari Fuller on what you will teach during the video
- Send in a photo of each application type up close to show the proper placement. The photo should show one row of each type, and can be done on a mannequin or client. If needed, you will have the option to buy a kit from Babe with all the tools & practice hair needed to complete this step at 50% off salon cost.
- Attend an educator training virtually or in person.
 - 1. The virtual training is 2 days in length, and 4 hours each day. There will be some homework to be done on the first day. The cost for this is \$100.
 - 2. The in person training may be held in various locations. It is also 2 days, and 12-15 hours in length total. You will be responsible to pay your own travel, hotel and food expenses, to and from the training. There is no cost for the actual training once you are there.
